

Unpacking Cryopreserved Sperm that Arrives in a Dry-Ice Parcel



1. The samples will arrive in a Thermal Control Unit, packed with an appropriate amount of dry-ice for the journey.



2. Carefully open the package and locate the samples. Keep the samples buried in the dryice as warming them will affect the success of the IVF.



3. Quickly transfer the samples to a liquid nitrogen filled dewar.



4. The samples can be checked and moved to either a storage cane or goblet for return to bulk liquid nitrogen storage.
